Guided Journaling Prompts for Leviticus 8

Reflection: Understanding the Story

1. What Happened?

- What did you learn about the special ceremony Aaron and his sons went through to become priests? Describe what stood out to you.

2. Feeling Connected:

- How do you think Aaron and his sons felt during the ceremony? Would you have felt nervous, excited, or something else? Why?

Personal Application: Bringing It to Your Life

3. Following Instructions:

- In the story, Moses did exactly what God commanded. Can you think of a time when you followed instructions well? How did it feel afterward?

4. Special Roles:

- Aaron and his sons had a special job. Do you have special responsibilities at home or school? What do you enjoy about doing them?

5. Being Prepared:

- Just like the priests needed to be prepared, how do you get ready for your day? What makes you feel prepared?

Open-Ended Questions: Thinking Deeply

6. Listening to Guidance:

- God gave Moses very specific instructions. Why do you think it's important to listen to guidance from others? Who do you listen to in your life?

7. Community and Teamwork:

- The ceremony involved many people working together. Can you think of an example where teamwork is important in your life? How do you contribute to your team?

Prayer: Connecting with God

8. Thankfulness:

- Write a prayer thanking God for the guidance and people who help us learn and grow. Who are you grateful for in your life?

9. Asking for Help:

- If you ever feel unsure about your responsibilities, how might you ask God for help in your prayer?

10. Prayers for Others:

- Think of someone who has responsibilities like Aaron. Write a prayer asking God to help them in their important work.

Closing Thought: Remember that just like Aaron and his sons had unique roles, you also have unique roles to play every day. Let's seek to learn, grow, and help others through what we do!
