Take-Home Assignment: Understanding Leviticus 8

Introduction

- How did Moses help them prepare for their special job?
- Can you think of a time when you were chosen to do something special? How did it make you feel?

4. Role Play:

With your family, act out a small role-play based on Leviticus 8. You can pretend to be Moses, Aaron, or one of his sons. Use a towel or robe as special priest garments and act out the key parts of the story.

5. Reflect and Write:

Write a few sentences about what you learned from Leviticus 8. Think about these questions:

- What does it mean to be prepared for a special job?
- How can you prepare yourself for responsibilities in your life?
