Take-Home Assignment: Understanding Leviticus 10

Dear Students and Families,

Today, we discussed Leviticus 10, a story from the Bible that teaches us about important lessons on obedience and respect. Below are some activities you can do at home to explore this story further. This should take about 15 minutes to complete.

1. Read Together:

Gather with your family and read Leviticus 10 together. Discuss what happens in the story and the main characters involved.

2. Story Reflection:

- Why do you think it was important for Aaron's sons, Nadab and Abihu, to follow God's instructions carefully?
- What happens when they don't follow instructions?
- How can we apply the lesson of following instructions to our daily lives?

3. Creative Drawing:

Draw a picture that shows a scene from Leviticus 10. It can be Aaron and his sons, the altar, or any part of the story that you find most interesting. Share your drawing with your family and explain why you chose that scene.

4. Obedience Chart:

Create an "Obedience Chart" to hang in a common area of your home. On this chart, list some rules or instructions that are important to your family. Decorate it and talk about how following these rules helps your family stay happy and safe, just like following God's laws helped the Israelites.

5. Discussion Questions:

With your family, discuss the following:

- How does the story of Nadab and Abihu teach us about respect?
- Can you think of a time when following an instruction kept you safe or helped you learn something new?
- Why is it important to listen carefully to both your family and God's teachings?

We hope these activities help you understand the importance of respect and obedience from the story of Leviticus 10. We look forward to hearing about what you learned and created!
