Key Verse: Leviticus 20:7 (NIV)

"Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the Lord your God."

Creative Ways to Memorize:

1. Rhyme:

- Create a simple rhyme to help them remember:

"Set yourself apart, and be holy too,
For God is the Lord, that's what we must do."

2. Song:

- Use the tune of a simple nursery rhyme like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star":

"Consecrate yourselves and be,
Holy, holy, just for Me.
I am the Lord, your God above,
Follow Me and show My love."

3. Motions:

- Create motions for each key word or phrase:

- "Consecrate" – Pretend to hold a crown over your head.
- "Yourselves" – Point to yourself.
- "Be holy" – Stretch arms up to the sky.
- "Lord your God" – Place hands over your heart.

4. Short Challenge:

- Have a challenge where students create their own hand claps or taps for each word or phrase of the verse, encouraging teamwork and rhythm.
