Activity 1: Character Masks

Objective: Understand the roles and responsibilities of priests as described in Leviticus 21.

Instructions:

- Divide students into small groups of 4-5.
- Provide each group with paper plates, markers, and craft materials to make character masks representing priests.
- Each group will discuss what qualities they think a priest in Leviticus 21 should have and decorate their mask accordingly.

Roles:

- Reader: Reads a chosen verse from Leviticus 21 aloud to the group.
- Artist: Leads the mask decoration effort.
- Note Taker: Jots down key priestly qualities mentioned in the discussion.
- Presenter: Shares the completed mask and insights on priests with the class.

Discussion Prompts:

- What special qualities should a priest have based on Leviticus 21?
- Why do you think these rules were important?

Participation:

- Each student takes a turn in reading a verse to the group.
- Everyone participates in decorating the mask by contributing at least one element.

Activity 2: Role-Play Scenarios

Objective: Explore situations where priests must maintain special behaviors.

Instructions:

- Assign each group a scenario where a priest faces a decision based on Leviticus 21 regulations.
- Groups will create a short skit and act it out for the class, showing how a priest should behave in line with the chapter.

Roles:

- Director: Guides the formation of the skit.
- Script Writer: Drafts the dialogue for the scenario.
- Actors: Perform the parts within the skit.
- Costume Manager: Ensures props or simple costumes are used.

Discussion Prompts:

- How should the priest act in this scenario based on the rules in Leviticus 21?
- Why might these rules be important for maintaining order among the community?

Participation:

- Each student has a role in the skit production and performs in front of the class.

Activity 3: Levitical Law Crossword

Objective: Reinforce vocabulary and key concepts from Leviticus 21.

Instructions:

- Provide each group with a crossword puzzle based on terms and concepts from Leviticus 21.
- Puzzles should include words like "priest," "holy," "blemish," and other key terms.

Roles:

- Solver: Works on the puzzle using clues.
- Checker: Checks if the spellings are correct.
- Finding Clue: Looks back in the text for answers.
- Encourager: Keeps the group motivated and focused.

Discussion Prompts:

- What new words have you learned from Leviticus 21?
- Why do you think these specific words were important in the chapter?

Participation:

- Each student contributes by discussing and placing at least two words on the crossword.
