Key Verse: Leviticus 21:6

"They must be holy to their God and must not profane the name of their God."

Creative Ways to Memorize:

1. Rhyme Time:

- Create a simple rhyme: "Be holy to your God, do not profane; keep His name without a stain."
- Repeat the rhyme while clapping or tapping on the table to keep the rhythm.

2. Song:

- Use the melody of a familiar tune like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" to sing the verse:
- "They must be holy to their God, and must not profane the name of God."

3. Motions:

- "They must be holy" - Raise your hands high above your head.
- "to their God" - Point to the sky.
- "and must not profane" - Shake your head and wag your finger.
- "the name of their God" - Draw an invisible cross in the air.

4. Short Challenges:

- Word Puzzle: Create a word puzzle where students have to find and circle all the words from the verse.
- Verse Hunt: Print each word of the verse on separate cards, mix them up, and challenge students to arrange them in the correct order.
