Key Bible Verse: Numbers 9:23 (NIV) - "At the Lord's command they set out, and at his command they encamped. They obeyed the Lord's order in accordance with his command through Moses."

Creative Ways to Memorize:

1. Song: Create a simple melody using familiar tunes like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" to sing the verse. Repeat often so the students can easily sing along and remember.

2. Motion Game: Assign simple motions to keywords:

- "Lord's command": Point upward
- "Set out": March in place
- "Encamped": Sit down cross-legged
- "Obeyed": Salute

Practice the motions while saying the verse.

3. Rhyme Time:

- Come up with a short rhyme to aid memorization:

"At the Lord's command, they went and stayed,
Listening and obeying, they were unafraid."

4. Memory Challenge: Write each word of the verse on separate index cards. Shuffle them and challenge the students to arrange them in the correct order. Use this as a routine activity and offer a small prize for completing the task each day.
