## Guided Journaling Prompts for Numbers 15

### Understanding the Passage

#### 1. What Happens?

- Write down what you remember about the instructions God gave to Moses and the people in Numbers 15. What were they supposed to do when they offered sacrifices?

#### 2. Why Do You Think?

- Why do you think God gave these specific instructions to the Israelites? What do these rules help remind the people about who God is?

### Reflection

#### 3. Following Directions

- Think about a time when you had to follow important instructions. How did it feel, and why was it important to follow them carefully? Write about this experience.

#### 4. Forgiveness

- Numbers 15 talks about what to do if someone makes a mistake. Have you ever made a mistake and asked for forgiveness? How did you feel afterwards?

#### 5. Symbols and Reminders

- The Israelites wore tassels to remember God's commands. What is something (like a symbol or reminder) that helps you remember to do your best or to follow what you believe is right?

### Personal Application

#### 6. Living Today

- How can you apply what you learned from Numbers 15 in your life today? Is there a new habit or practice you want to start to better follow the instructions you think are important?

#### 7. Say Thanks

- Think about something you are thankful for today, especially related to learning and guidance. Why are you grateful for these things?

### Prayer

#### 8. Talking to God

- Write a short prayer asking God to help you follow His guidance in your life. You can also thank Him for giving instructions that help you live well.

### Open-Ended Connection

#### 9. Daily Life

- What lessons from Numbers 15 can help you with challenges you are facing this week? Is there something you'd like to do differently after reflecting on this chapter?
