Song Suggestion 1: "God's Instructions"

Paraphrase of lyrics:

- Verse 1: God gives us instructions to follow His way, to live in His love each and every day.

Song Suggestion 2: "Remember and Obey"

Paraphrase of lyrics:

Suggested Actions:

Connection to the lesson:

This song emphasizes the concept of remembrance and obedience found in Numbers 15, where Israelites are reminded of their covenant with God.

Worship Activity: "Tassels Craft"

Activity Description:

- Create tassels to attach to a piece of fabric or clothing.
- Discuss Numbers 15:37-41: Explain why God instructed the Israelites to add tassels to remind them of His commandments.
- As students make their tassels, encourage them to think about ways they can remember God's word in their daily lives.
