Guided Journaling Prompts for Deuteronomy 4

Reflection:

1. What do you think is the main message in Deuteronomy 4? Try to sum it up in your own words.
2. Why do you think it was important for the people to listen to Moses and follow God's instructions?
3. Describe a time when you needed to listen carefully to instructions. How did it help you?

Personal Application:

1. God asked the Israelites to remember what He has done for them. Can you list three things God has done for you or your family?
2. Moses taught the Israelites to follow God's commandments. How do you think following rules helps us in our daily lives?
3. Choose one way that you can show obedience to God this week. Write down what you will do and how you think it will make you feel.

Connecting to Daily Life:

1. The Israelites were reminded to be careful not to forget God. How can you remember to think about God in your day-to-day activities?
2. Imagine you are giving advice to a friend about the importance of listening carefully and following instructions. What would you tell them?
3. Think of a rule you follow at home or school. How does this rule help keep things organized or safe?

Prayer:

1. Write a thank-you note to God for the guidance and blessings He provides. What specific things are you grateful for today?
2. Think about something you need help with understanding or doing better. Write a prayer asking God for help and wisdom.
3. Pray for someone you know who needs help remembering God's love. Ask God to remind them that He is always with them.
