Assignment: Exploring Deuteronomy 10

Objective: To help students understand the teachings of Deuteronomy 10 and reflect on how these teachings can be applied in their own lives.

Instructions:

Read Deuteronomy 10 with a family member and then complete the activities below. Spend about 15 minutes on this reflection.

Read:

Reflect and Discuss:

1. Summary:

- With your family member, discuss what Deuteronomy 10 is about in your own words. Who do you think is speaking in this chapter?

2. Key Verses:

- Pick your favorite verse from Deuteronomy 10. Write it down and explain why you like it.

Activities:

1. Heart and Soul:

- Deuteronomy 10:12 talks about loving and serving God with all your heart and soul. Draw a big heart on a piece of paper. Inside the heart, write or draw ways you can show love and care to others, just like how it's explained in the chapter.

2. Kindness Scavenger Hunt:

- As a family, list actions that show kindness and caring for others, similar to God's care mentioned in Deuteronomy 10. Throughout the week, try to do as many of these actions as you can. At the end of the week, share with each other what you did and how it made you feel.

Questions to Discuss:

1. What Does God Ask?

- According to Deuteronomy 10, what does God want from us? Write down three things and talk about how you can do them in your daily life.

2. Helping Others:

- In Deuteronomy 10, there's a part about caring for strangers. Have you helped anyone new recently? Share the experience with your family and discuss how it made you both feel.

3. Being Grateful:

- Deuteronomy 10:21 calls God our praise. List three things you are thankful for and share them with your family.

Mini Project:

- Family Coat of Arms:

- Create a family coat of arms that depicts values from Deuteronomy 10, such as kindness, love for God, and helping others. Use drawings, symbols, or words. Hang this in a shared space as a reminder.
