Guided Journaling Prompts for Deuteronomy 12

Reflection:

1. What is one thing you remember about the rules God gave the Israelites in Deuteronomy 12?
2. How do these rules show that God wanted His people to worship Him in a special way?
3. Why do you think it was important for the Israelites to have a special place for worship?

Personal Application:

1. Think about a special place where you like to talk to God. What makes it special for you?
2. Why is it important for you to have your own way of showing that God is important to you?
3. How can you remember to focus on God in your everyday activities, just like the Israelites had to focus on Him when worshiping?

Prayer:

1. Write a short prayer thanking God for giving us places to worship and ways to show our love for Him.
2. Ask God to help you remember Him in all you do, just as the Israelites were reminded in Deuteronomy 12.
3. Pray for courage to follow God's instructions in your own life, and help others to do the same.

Connection to Daily Life:

1. Who helps you remember and keep special rules in your life, like the Israelites had to with God's rules?
2. Describe a time when you had to do something special to show someone you cared. How is this similar to worshiping God?
3. Think of a way you can make a regular activity, like eating a meal, a time to remember and thank God. How could you make this a habit?
