## Key Verse:

Deuteronomy 12:28 (NIV): "Be careful to obey all these regulations I am giving you, so that it may always go well with you and your children after you, because you will be doing what is good and right in the eyes of the Lord your God."

## Creative Ways to Memorize:

### 1. Song:

Create a simple melody to the verse and sing it together. You might use the tune of a well-known nursery rhyme like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star." This can make it easier for children to remember the words through repetition and rhythm.

### 2. Rhyme and Actions:

Break the verse into smaller parts and add hand motions or actions. For example:

- "Be careful to obey" - Point to your eyes like you're being vigilant.
- "all these regulations I am giving you" - Pretend to hand out rules like a scroll.
- "so that it may always go well with you" - Give two thumbs up.
- "and your children after you" - Point to imaginary children behind you.
- "because you will be doing what is good and right" - Make a heart shape with your hands.
- "in the eyes of the Lord your God" - Look up and point upwards.

### 3. Short Challenges:

Use a call-and-response game. The teacher says a part of the verse, and the children echo it back. Gradually increase the challenge by saying more words before they repeat.

### 4. Craft Activity:

Create a small poster or bookmark with the verse written on it. Encourage children to decorate it with drawings or stickers related to the words (like hearts for "good and right" or eyes for "in the eyes of the Lord"). This visual activity will help reinforce the verse in their memory.
