## Take-Home Assignment: Exploring Deuteronomy 12

### Objective:

To understand the importance of worshipping God in the way He commands, as outlined in Deuteronomy 12, and to reflect on how we can practice our faith in our daily lives.

### Assignment Instructions:

#### 1. Read Together:

- Gather with a family member and read Deuteronomy 12 aloud. If you have a children's Bible, you can also use that version to help understand the chapter's main messages.

#### 2. Key Themes to Discuss:

- Talk about why God wanted the Israelites to worship Him in specific ways.
- Discuss why it is important to follow God's instructions and how this can help us in our own lives.

#### 3. Reflection Questions:

- Why do you think God asked the Israelites to destroy other places of worship?
- How can we make sure we honor and worship God in the right way today?
- What are some ways we can show respect and love towards God during worship?

#### 4. Family Activity: Create a "Worship Plan":

- Work together to create a simple plan for how your family will worship God this week. Include elements like prayer, songs, and reading Bible stories.
- List the special place in your home where you can gather for family worship time.

#### 5. Drawing Exercise:

- Draw a picture of your family worship time. Include everyone in your family and show what activities you plan to do, such as singing or reading.

#### 6. Prayer Writing:

- Write a short prayer thanking God for guiding us and helping us worship Him correctly. Ask each family member to contribute one line to the prayer.

#### 7. Family Worship Journal:

- Start a family worship journal. Each time you gather, write a short entry about what you learned, how you felt, and any special moment that happened during your time together.

Be sure to complete these activities with the help of your family and share your thoughts and drawings when we meet again in class.
