## Activity 1: Blessings and Choices

### Instructions:

1. Read the selected verses from Deuteronomy 30:1-10 that talk about blessings and returning to God.
2. Discuss what choices lead to blessings in the verses.

### Roles:

- Reader: Reads the verses aloud.
- Recorder: Writes down each blessing mentioned.
- Discussion Leader: Guides the conversation using prompts.

### Discussion Prompts:

- What are some of the blessings mentioned in these verses?
- Why do you think making good choices leads to blessings?
- Can you think of a time when you made a good choice and something good happened?

### Participation:

- Each student shares a personal choice they've made and its outcome.
- Design a "Blessings Choice Board" where students draw or write one choice and its blessing.

## Activity 2: The Power of Choosing Life

### Instructions:

1. Read Deuteronomy 30:11-20 focusing on choosing life and good.
2. Discuss the reasons for choosing life.

### Roles:

- Reader: Reads the passage aloud.
- Artist: Draws a "Choices Tree" with options on its branches.
- Discussion Leader: Asks questions and keeps everyone on task.

### Discussion Prompts:

- What does it mean to "choose life" in these verses?
- How do our daily choices reflect choosing life and good?
- What can we do to make better choices every day?

### Participation:

- Each student adds a leaf with a daily choice they can make to the "Choices Tree."
- Share one way they can choose to support life and goodness in a week.

## Activity 3: Listening and Obeying

### Instructions:

1. Read Deuteronomy 30:11-16 focusing on listening to and obeying God's commandments.
2. Role-play listening scenarios.

Roles:

- Reader: Reads the passage aloud.
- Role-Player 1: Acts out a situation of listening and not obeying.
- Role-Player 2: Acts out a situation of listening and obeying.

Discussion Prompts:

- How does listening help us make better choices according to these verses?
- Why is it important to not only listen but also obey?
- What can happen if we only listen but do not follow through with action?

Participation:

- Each student shares how listening and obeying has helped them in the past.
- Come up with a class "Listening Pledge" to practice this in daily activities.
