Songs for 1 Samuel 21:

1. "God Will Provide"

Paraphrase of Lyrics:

- Verse 1: "When we are in need, and don't know what to do, God will always see, and provide for me and you."
- Chorus: "God will always provide, wherever we go. His love will be our guide, and His grace we'll know."

Suggested Actions:

- Pretend to be searching with a hand above the eyes during "When we are in need."

Connection to Lesson:

- Encourages bravery and faith, like David who trusted in God's protection while on the run from Saul.

Worship Activities:

1. Bread of Presence Craft

- Description: Create paper or clay models of the "Bread of Presence" that represents God's provision.
- Connection: Based on David receiving the showbread, this activity helps students understand God's provision and care.

2. Trust Circle

- Description: Students sit in a circle, and each shares a moment they trusted God, reflecting on times they saw God's provision like David.
- Connection: Reinforces the lesson of trusting God in difficult circumstances.

3. Act It Out

- Description: A simple skit portraying the interaction between David and Ahimelech to bring the story to life.

- Connection: Engages students with the narrative, emphasizing the themes of trust and divine assistance.
