Visual 1: David at Nob

- Illustration Description: Create a simple cartoon of a small village set in biblical times, with a few huts to represent Nob. Show David in the forefront speaking to Ahimelech the priest at the door of the tabernacle.
- Caption: "David seeks help from Ahimelech in the village of Nob."
