Key Bible Verse:

1 Samuel 24:12 (NIV)

"May the Lord judge between you and me. And may the Lord avenge the wrongs you have done to me, but my hand will not touch you."

Creative Ways to Memorize:

1. Rhyme and Rhythm:

Create a simple rhyme to help remember the verse:

"Between you and me, let God be the judge.

Though wrongs were done, I won't hold a grudge."

2. Hand Motions:

- "May the Lord judge" – Raise both hands upward.

- "Between you and me" – Point back and forth between yourself and a partner.

- "Avenge the wrongs" – Pretend to sweep something away with one hand.

- "But my hand will not touch you" – Shake your head and hold both hands out in a 'stop' gesture.

3. Sing a Tune:

Use the tune of a familiar nursery rhyme like "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star":

"May the Lord judge you and me,

He'll avenge wrongs, you'll see,

My hand won't touch you, I'll stay,

God decides the rightful way."

4. Challenge:

Set a timer and see how many times you can recite the verse in one minute. Encourage students to break their personal records each day.

5. Verse Relay:

With a group of students, stand in a circle. Each student says one word of the verse in turn, going around the circle until the entire verse is recited. Repeat faster until the whole group knows it by heart.
