Take-Home Assignment: Reflection on '2 Samuel 1'

Dear Students,

Today, we learned about '2 Samuel 1,' which tells the story of King David hearing the news about the death of King Saul and his son Jonathan. This chapter teaches us important lessons about respect, mourning, and honoring others. Here is a take-home assignment that you can do with your family to deepen your understanding of this Bible chapter.

Activity 1: Story Recap

Questions to Inspire Creativity:

1. What qualities do you admire in this person?
2. How have they made a positive impact on your life?

Take a few moments to think about the importance of forgiving others and celebrating the good in them, just as David did for Saul and Jonathan. Share your thoughts with your family.
